What is the Centennial Society?	What is the requested donation?	How do I reserve my plaque?
<p>The HTS Centennial Society is a new giving level designed to celebrate Holy Trinity School's 100th Anniversary through the placement of a Wall of Honor located in the school accommodating commemorative plaques for 100 donors.</p>	<p>A donation of \$2,013 is requested for membership in the Centennial Society. With 100 Centennial Society memberships, Holy Trinity School will realize a gain of approximately \$200,000 to its endowment fund, further strengthening the school's financial base for current and future generations of students.</p>	<p>Simply complete the enclosed donor card and indicate if you intend to make your Centennial Society donation in a lump sum or over a four-year pledge. All donors will receive written confirmation of Centennial Society membership and a plaque registration number. At the appropriate time (approximately Fall 2010) all society members will be provided with a donor packet indicating their options for plaque dedications.</p>
<p>Who may be recognized on a plaque?</p> <p>A donor may choose to commemorate his/her family, living or deceased, honor a favorite HTS teacher, dedicate a Scripture passage, or share a personal reflection on what HTS means to them. The Wall of Honor will be permanently placed in a central location at the school's entrance where it will be viewed by the school community and visitors on a daily basis.</p>	<p>Is there a pledge payment option?</p> <p>Yes. Donors may choose to pay their Centennial Society membership over four years, with a minimum of \$513 due in year one, and \$500 due in each of years two, three and four. Centennial Society members will be sent an annual reminder when their pledge payment is due.
